Our strategic objectives can be summarised as follows:

- To deliver a consistently excellent standard of Steiner Waldorf education to every pupil in the school.
- Subject to not compromising on quality, to offer a Waldorf education to as many children as the school can properly accommodate.
- To develop the Steiner Waldorf curriculum to meet changing conditions in the world and to ensure it meets the needs of the current pupil population.
- To ensure the school robustly safeguards the health, safety and well-being of all pupils in the school community
- To be a comprehensive school, educating pupils with a wide range of abilities, predominantly in mixed-ability classes.
- To be an accessible school so that, as far as possible, social and financial status do not act as barriers to entry and class groups include pupils from a wide range of backgrounds.
- To develop new Waldorf teachers through a classroom-based teacher training programme, both for the benefit of the school and for the wider Waldorf school movement.
- To support excellence in education by training and developing all current teachers and support staff in the school.
- To maintain financial viability such that investment in the school's infrastructure, facilities and resources is sufficient to develop and maintain an excellent school.
- To ensure that the school is a sustainable enterprise in every sense, continuously developing to meet emerging challenges.
